The Boulevard provides high quality, cost-effective medical respite care, holistic support and transitional housing services to help ill and injured homeless adults **break the cycle of homelessness, restore their health, and rebuild their lives**. At our 64-bed Medical Respite residence, we meet our clients' basic needs while providing onsite healthcare, case management, counseling, and support to move to housing stability. In our Housing & Health Programs, The Boulevard provides case management and support for homeless Chicagoans to secure and maintain permanent stable housing. Through these initiatives, The Boulevard is changing the lives of approximately 640 individuals annually and playing an important role in Chicago's efforts to reduce homelessness.
